



Installation Safety Guidelines

The following is a list of precautionary measures we are taking to ensure your safety and the safety of our contractors during the installation process. Our goal is to limit the amount of exposure between customer and KBS contractors as well as other trades on the job.

1. Please be sure your space is ready for installation. If you are responsible for the removal of your old kitchen, please make sure everything is removed from the kitchen and that the space is prepared for cabinetry install.
2. Once KBS begins the installation we will be the only trade working in the space. We are not permitted to work side by side with any other trades.
3. We can arrange one daily meeting with the contractor, either in the morning or afternoon. Our contractor will arrange a convenient time with you.
4. All face to face interactions require social distancing and face masks are preferred.
5. Please keep your family and pets away from the work area throughout the entire process.
